

Muhyiddin Arrives In Melbourne For Working Visit

MELBOURNE (Australia), Nov 10 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin arrived here Saturday to begin a nine-day working visit to Australia.

Muhyiddin, who is accompanied by his wife, Puan Sri Norainee Abdul Rahman, have a tight schedule during his visit to Melbourne in Victoria, the Gold Coast and Brisbane in Queensland until Nov 18.

He is expected to deliver a keynote address at the fourth World Chinese Economic Forum (WCEF) organised by the Asian Strategic and Leadership Institute (Asli), the first time it is being held outside Malaysia, on Monday.

On Tuesday, Muhyiddin will attend a briefing on the G.A.T.E.WAYS Brainwaves Club programme in Melbourne before departing for the Gold Coast.

The deputy prime minister will attend a briefing on the development of the Petronas Brisbane joint-venture in the Gladstone LNG (liquefied natural gas) and meet the Malaysian scientific diaspora while in the Gold Coast.

Muhyiddin, who is also education minister, will be briefed on the Boyston Employment, a programme that enables young people to seek employment in Brisbane, and meet the Malaysian community in Melbourne and the Gold Coast.
