

**Malaysia Has Good Track Record In Loan Payment - Ahmad Husni

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 18 (Bernama) - Malaysia has a good track record in loan payment, said Second Finance Minister Datuk Seri Ahmad Husni Hanadzlah.

He said this was possible because the government was firm in managing the country's debt by ensuring that revenue exceeded management expenditure.

"In other words, we don't borrow to pay salaries. We just borrow for development purposes that give multiply effect," he said winding up debate on the Supply Bill 2013 in parliament here Thursday.

Ahmad Husni said the government would continue to ensure that all loans taken could be repaid and not only consider leverage when applying for funding.

"We are so stringent in debt management that we merge both to ensure it does not exceed 55 percent. We are cautious and serious in addressing debt."
