

Parliament: Opposition Too Received Political Donations - Nazri

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 18 (Bernama) -- The Opposition should not question Sabah Umno's RM40 million political donation from unknown sources because DAP had also received RM3.5 million from supporters to build a new building in Penang, said Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Seri Mohamed Nazri Abdul Aziz.

Nazri said it was not an offence for any party, including the Opposition, to receive donations for their political activities.

"There is no problem. Any party can receive donations. We understand DAP had also received. But Umno received more because there are more Umno supporters.

"Political donations are not an offence. But if it is to become an offence, we are ready to enact such laws," he told Tan Kok Wai (DAP-Cheras) during a question and answer session in Dewan Rakyat here Thursday.

The Attorney-General's Chambers had decided that there was no element of corruption in the case against Sabah Umno receiving donations.
