

Liow Confident MCA Will Rise Up Again Come Next GE

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 20 (Bernama) -- MCA deputy president Datuk Seri Liow Tiong Lai is confident that MCA, which took a severe beating in the last general election (GE) in 2008, will rise up again come the next GE.

Liow, who is also Health Minister, said the good performance by the country after the implementation of the government's transformation initiatives, particularly in the economic landscape, had changed the perception of the people, including the Chinese community, who had now returned to support the Barisan Nasional (BN).
