

**BN Projects Implemented After Considering People's Interest - Mahdzir

ALOR SETAR, Oct 28 (Bernama) - Kedah opposition leader Datuk Seri Mahdzir Khalid said projects implemented by Barisan Nasional (BN) took into account the people's interest and not made haphazardly.

He said that the 99 East project in Langkawi costing RM1.2 billion which began in 2007 was planned to be an international standard golf course.

"The project had been partially completed. The state government should continue and not stop it after winning the general election in 2008," he said when met at Felda Lubuk Merbau today where eight heads of cattle were sacrificed by Padang Terap Umno division to mark Aidiladha.

Kedah Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Azizan Abdul Razak claimed that four projects implemented by the BN state government had forced the PAS state government to be in debt.

Mahdzir said the Langkawi project was a joint venture between Kedah Corporation Berhad (KCB) and Terra Monda Development Pte Ltd to develop 144 hectares land in Bukit Malut.
