

**Pakatan States Deferring Implementation Of Aes Will Be Referred To  
Attorney-General's Chambers - Rahim  
Bernama

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 31 Bernama) -- The Transport Ministry will be referring to the Attorney-General's Chambers the matter of Pakatan states deferring implementation of the Automated Enforcement System (AES), said its deputy minister Datuk Abdul Rahim Bakri.

He said the AES should not be made political capital by the Pakatan states because it was to protect the people besides ensuring proper discipline on the roads.

"This (Pakatan states not implementing the AES) has to be referred to the AG's Chambers . I am not very clear on the legal provisions involved, whether they have the authority to do so (not implement), especially concerning traffic lights which come under the local authorities.

"So too federal roads and highways operated by Plus in these states," he told Bernama after participating in an interview on Bernama's Radio24 at Wisma Bernama here Wednesday.
