

Political Parties Give Positive Feedback To EC In Conducting Coming Elections

KUALA TERENGGANU, Dec 6 (Bernama)-- Political parties on both sides of the divide have given positive feedback to the Election Commission (EC) in carrying out the coming 13th general election.

EC deputy secretary, Datuk Noordin Che Ngah said following the series of briefings and simulation exercise conducted by the EC nationwide, the political parties concerned had an increasingly clearer picture and understanding of several confusing issues that arose.

"The response has been good so far and what is important is that we have explained the confusion among the leaders and members of the political parties," he said after a briefing and simulation exercise, here, Thursday.

About 50 representatives from parties such as Umno, MCA, MIC, Gerakan, PAS, DAP and Parti Keadilan Rakyat in the state attended the session.

Noordin said the confusion that arose were mainly about postal voting, early voting and use of delible ink in the coming elections.
