

**Malaysia To Improve Public Perception On Corruption - Najib  
Bernama

KUALA LUMPUR, Dec 7 (Bernama) -- Malaysia will continue to fight corruption and improve its standing in the Corruption Perception Index (CPI), said Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak.

The Prime Minister in his latest tweet Thursday night said: "Malaysia moved up another six places in Corruption Perception Index, making us third amongst Asean nations. A standing we will continue improving on."

He said this in commenting the Transparency International announcement of Malaysia's improved position in the CPI from 60th spot last year to 54th spot this year.

Malaysia scored 49 out of 100 on the survey which gauges the perceived level of public sector corruption among 176 countries.

Malaysia is ranked third among Asian nations behind Singapore which scored 87 points, followed by Brunei in second place with 55 points.
