

**UN's 'Half-Recognition' Of Palestine Reflects An Unjust World, Says Mahathir

KUALA LUMPUR, Dec 12 (Bernama) -- Former Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad said today the United Nations' 'half-recognition' of Palestine was reflective of the strong taking what they will and the weak giving in what they must.

Not according full recognition to Palestine was proof that people were living in a world where there was no justice, where the rule of law prevailed not, and where might was right, he said.

"There was no state of Israel where it is now. There was only the state of Palestine then. Now there is a state of Israel but no state of Palestine. Why?

"Because Israel, this artificial creation of the West, together with its satellite, the United States of America, is against acknowledging the existence of the state of Palestine," he said in his latest entry in his blog at chedet.cc today.

Dr Mahathir said there was only a Palestinian Authority, a meaningless entity found nowhere else in the world and this entity was not allowed to collect all the taxes due to it.
