

**Winds Of Change In Sabah Politics More Favourable For BN - Pairin

TAWAU, Dec 12 (Bernama) -- Parti Bersatu Sabah (PBS) president Tan Sri Joseph Pairin Kitingan is confident that the winds of change in Sabah politics are more favourable for Barisan Nasional (BN) this time than in the last general election in 2008.
