

**MUBARAK Can Link Members And Families With Government - Rosmah

MELAKA, Dec 13 (Bernama) -- The Malaysian Council of Former Elected Representatives (MUBARAK) can become a bridge between ex-lawmakers and their families with the government for continued development of the country, said the prime minister's wife, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor.
