

Raja Muda Of Perlis Urges UniMAP To Expand International Network

KANGAR, Dec 13 (Bernama) -- The Raja Muda of Perlis, Tuanku Syed Faizuddin Putra Jamalullail urged Universiti Malaysia Perlis (UniMAP) to expand its international network to promote itself at a global level.
