

Agong Pays Last Respects To The Late Tun Dr Lim Keng Yaik

PETALING JAYA, Dec 25 (Bernama) -- Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah today paid his last respects to former Gerakan president, Tun Dr Lim Keng Yaik.

The King, who arrived at 11.10am, spent about 10 minutes at the residence of the late Dr Lim, accompanied by the latter's son, Datuk Lim Si Pin, who is also and the Gerakan Youth chief.

He was earlier received by Gerakan president Tan Sri Dr Koh Tsu Koon upon his arrival. Prior to that, Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak and his wife Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor were present to give their last respects to the late Dr Lim. The wife of the deputy Prime Minister, Puan Sri Norainee Abdul Rahman also paid her last respects to the late Dr Lim.

Dr Lim, who was a cabinet minister for 22 years, died Saturday at the age of 73.

Dr Lim, who was Energy, Water and Communications minister from 2004 until 2008, left behind wife Toh Puan Wong Yoon Chuan and three children.

His body would be cremated at the Cheras Creamtorium after being accorded national honour.
