

Pakatan Rakyat Pledges Will Backfire On Itself In The 13th GE - Ampang Umno Chief

KUALA LUMPUR, Nov 28 (Bernama) -- The people in Selangor at the grassroots have started to lose their patience with the attitude of the opposition in not fulfilling the pledges of its manifesto even though they have administered the state for four years, according to Ampang Umno chief Datuk Ismail Kijo.

He said the attitude of the opposition in flip-flopping on fulfilling its manifesto would backfire on itself in the 13th general election.

"Wherever we go, the people are voicing their impatience to give victory to the Barisan Nasional," he said when met after listening to Umno president Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak's address at the Umno General Assembly here Tuesday.

He said the people were fed up as they were now demanding the promises made by opposition Selangor government through legal channels.

Recently, 2,020 single mothers demanded in court for arrears of allowance for single mothers as promised by the opposition coalition government and apartment residents are demanding that they be compensated as they did not enjoy the subsidy for the first 20 cubic meter of water, he said.
