

Muhyiddin's seven commandments for victory

TAN Sri Muhyiddin Yassin has sounded the war drums, instructing all Umno election operation centres to be in full swing with immediate effect.

The party deputy president said those given the responsibility to head the centres should ensure matters related to logistics were sorted out.

"There is not much time left before the general election is called and Umno should not be caught unprepared," he said.

"The Opposition has been travelling around in jets and ferrying their people on buses and lorries, attacking our fortresses," said Muhyiddin, who is the Barisan Nasional election director.

The order to activate fully all the operation centres was one of Muhyiddin's "seven commandments of victory", which he listed down in his winding-up speech.

The others included being loyal to the party and its leadership by accepting all the decisions on election issues, including the selection of candidates.

"Our strategies must be flawless and everything that is decided by the leadership is translated into an effective action.

"Every member has a role to play, no matter how small the task is. We should be able to anticipate the enemies' moves," he said.

Muhyiddin said while he felt he had been working hard by making numerous rounds to the states, he was humbled after discovering that party president Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak's visits outnumbered his.

"This is a challenge to me and to all of us to work harder, to ensure that the *rakyat* is ready to give Umno and Barisan Nasional a new and stronger mandate for the next five years."
