

PM Najib: Win-win for both countries

JOHOR BARU: Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak who met Singapore Deputy Prime Minister Tharman Shanmugaratnam said both countries were enthusiastic about complementing each other.

"Singapore has, in principle, endorsed a high-speed train project which is subject to a detailed study. It can be a win-win for both countries," he said yesterday.

Najib said both sides would also release details of the two pieces of land to be jointly developed in line with the settlement under the Points of Agreement, adding that a proposed wellness centre in Iskandar would also be discussed next month.

"Singapore will be the commercial and financial hub while southern Johor will be a high-end quality area," he said, adding that Johor would benefit from the enormous influx of people, talent and capital inflow.
