

**Insight into the life and times of Rosmah soon**

KUALA LUMPUR: Malaysians can get a glimpse into Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor's life when an biography of the Prime Minister's wife is launched early next year.

Yayasan Amanah Perdana Malaysia chairman Shamsulbahrin Ludin said the 164-page *Rosmah Mansor* would be an insight into her life, from childhood until present times.

"A few topics of public interest will be addressed in the book," he said at a press conference after the book's soft launch by the Sultan of Pahang Sultan Ahmad Shah Al-Musta'in Billah ibni Almarhum Sultan Abu Bakar yesterday.

Shamsulbahrin said Rosmah's marriage to Najib, the challenges she faced as the wife of a Prime Minister would be the highlights.

The book also touches on Rosmah's involvement in community works, especially in developing the Permata Negara programme, her engagement with non-governmental organisations and her participation in programmes at the international level.

Shamsulbahrin, who is also the publisher, said: "Some of the facts presented in the book have never been told to anyone. There would also be a question-and-answer section to counter criticisms levelled against her."

The RM150 book would be made available at the end of January.

At the event, Rosmah, who celebrated her birthday yesterday, was surprised with a cake and a song.

Also present were Royal Consort Sultanah of Pahang Sultanah Kalsom Abdullah and Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak.
