

Najib to make one-day visit to Sabah next month

KOTA KINABALU: Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak will be celebrating Hari Raya with the folks in the northern Kota Belud district and Sandakan in the east coast during his one-day visit to Sabah on Sept 2.

The Prime Minister is scheduled to attend the Hari Raya open house of Parliament Speaker Tan Sri Pandikar Amin Mulia in Kota Belud soon after his arrival.

Chief Minister Datuk Seri Musa Aman said Najib would then head to Sandakan to open the Kinabatangan, Beluran, Sandakan, Batu Sapi and Libaran Umno division meetings.

Abdullah praised Najib for being a hardworking leader with a strong will to fulfil the plans he had set out to achieve.
