

BN Does Not Neglect Siamese Community In Kelantan

BACHOK, Feb 1 (Bernama) -- The people of Siamese origin in Kelantan were assured that their welfare would be looked after by the federal government.

Kelantan Barisan Nasional (BN) deputy chairman Datuk Dr Awang Adek Hussin said although they were a minority group, their support was needed to ensure victory for BN in the coming 13th general election.

"This means their votes mean a lot to BN," he told reporters after meeting residents of Kampung Baru Balai and Tawang here Friday.
