

Kelantanese Should Reject Leaders Who Try To Cause Disunity

KOTA BAHARU, Feb 2 (Bernama) -- The people of Kelantan should reject leaders who try to cause disunity by sowing the feelings of hatred, making wild allegations and adopting extremism.

Kelantan Umno Liaison head Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed said the people of Kelantan who loved solidarity and peace should always realise that factionalism would not bring any benefit and instead would be detrimental to them.

"The Kelantan people loves solidarity and peace that we want to foster through the feelings of love and not hatred.

"We want leaders who are chosen by the people who instil the feelings of love, not leaders who like to spread lies, and are abrasive and extreme in their stand," he told reporters after officiating the 'Maulidur Rasul Perdana Perpaduan 2013' celebration at the Tanjung Rural Transformation Centre (RTC), here today.

Mustapa, who is also the International Trade and Industry Minister, said the leaders who disliked solidarity would be more active in the run up to the 13th general election (GE13).
