

Investors Should Look At Perlis As Investment Location

MEDAN, Feb 3 (Bernama) -- The Raja Muda of Perlis, Tuanku Syed Faizuddin Putra Jamalullail has invited foreign investors intending to invest in Malaysia to also look at Perlis as an investment location with potentials.

He said the political stability, security and minimal risk of natural disaster were among the factors that could attract investors to Perlis besides the low cost of living and expanding infrastructural facilities, utility and information and communication technology (ICT) network.

Speaking at the opening of the Perlis food promotion here today, he said that Perlis was also a producer of high quality human capital with the existence of the Universiti Malaysia Perlis (UniMAP), Universiti Teknologi Mara (UiTM), Politeknik Tuanku Syed Sirajuddin (PTSS), Allianze University College of Medical Science (AUCMS) and the Kolej Antarabangsa Teknologi & Profesional (KATPM).

He said that the tasty Perlis food that had been promoted at 17 locations worldwide would also attract the investors and tourists visiting the northern-most state in Peninsular Malaysia.

The Perlis food promotion had previously been held in several countries including China, Australia, United Kingdom, Japan, Vietnam, New Zealand, Uzbekistan, Qatar, Thailand as well as several locations in Indonesia.

Meanwhile at the signing of the memorandum of understanding (MoU) between the Perlis Media Club (KEMPs) and the Aliansi Jurnalis Independen (AJI Kota Medan), here, the Raja Muda said the cordial relations between Malaysia and Indonesia should be nurtured through various forums including close cooperation between the media of both countries.

In this regard, he hoped the mass media of both countries would play their roles not only in promoting ties between the two countries but also ease the tension that could have been caused by misinterpretation of various issues raised by certain groups.
