

**PLUS Plans To Expand "Wow" Service**

BUTTERWORTH, Feb 3 (Bernama) -- PLUS Malaysia Berhad (PLUS) plans to expand its 'Workshop on Wheels' (WOW) service to encompass all the tolled highways it is operating by the end of the year, said its managing director/chief executive officer Datuk Noorizah Abdul Hamid.

She said currently the service was being provided in the northern and southern parts of the North-South Expressway (NSE).
