

Muhyiddin Makes One-Day Visit To Perak Tomorrow

IPOH, Jan 4 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin will make a one-day working visit to Perak tomorrow.

According to the programme released by the Deputy Prime Minister's Office, he is scheduled to attend five programmes in the Batang Padang District.

Muhyiddin's visit will begin in the morning with a closed-door meeting with the Perak Barisan Nasional (BN) at the Kompleks Sukan Proton City, Tanjung Malim.

This will be followed by a visit to the Proton plant at Proton City where he will have lunch with the Proton employees.

In the afternoon, Muhyiddin will open the annual general meeting of Majlis Pendekar Malaysia (MPM) at the Dewan Utama, Politeknik Sultan Azlan Shah in Behrang.

Subsequently, the Deputy Prime Minister is scheduled to attend a gathering with the Parent-Teachers' Association, Teachers Club and youth non-governmental organisations (NGOs) in Perak at the Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan Bidor square in Bidor.

Muhyiddin will conclude his working visit by attending a 1Malaysia gathering with the people and having dinner at the Universiti Pendidikan Sultan Idris (UPSI) field in Tanjung Malim before returning to Kuala Lumpur.
