

**Najib Boards Aircraft With 1Malaysia Integration Programme Entourage

KUANTAN, Jan 5 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak and wife, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor, arrived here today, on board an aircraft, accompanied by several community leaders, brought specially from Sabah and Sarawak.

The AirAsia Airbus A320 landed at the Royal Malaysian Air Force Air Base here at noon.

The entourage comprised the implementers of the '1Malaysia Integration Programme' with AirAsia, which saw free flight offers by the airline for the Sabah, Sarawak and Peninsular route, for a fixed period.

According to the head of the 1Malaysia Integration Programme with Air Asia, Shahril Hafizi Razali, the entourage of 100 people from Sabah and Sarawak represented several communities.

"The implementation is aimed at bringing communities in Sabah and Sarawak to meet up with communities in the peninsula.

"This is why, representatives from the communities of Sabah and Sarawak are wearing their traditional costumes to share with the communities in the peninsula, in an orientation session which will be arranged," he said.

He said, according to schedule, the entourage would conduct visits to, among others, the Automobile Industrial area and the Pulai Serai Community Centre in Pekan, before returning to the national capital for more visits.
