

Give Najib Chance, Time To Fully Implement Transformation Programmes - KK BN Youth

KOTA KINABALU, Feb 7 (Bernama) -- The Kota Kinabalu Barisan Nasional (BN) youth movement has made an impassioned call to Sabahans to give Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak a chance and time to fully implement his transformation programmes.

Kota Kinabalu Umno youth division vice chief Muammar Julkarnain said this was necessary as Najib's transformation process for change would certainly take time to achieve the desired results.

In drumming up support for the BN to wrest the Kota Kinabalu Parliamentary seat from the DAP in the coming general election, he said the Prime Minister had proven his mettle and capability in championing the cause of the people who are from varied background and belief.

"Give Najib's leadership a chance. Obviously we have enjoyed and seen tremendous development and progress in Kota Kinabalu under the Barisan Nasional government.

"The opposition leaders are only good at making sweet promises...but they cannot deliver. That's why we should not risk and gamble away our future by voting for the opposition," he told reporters after chairing the "BN 1KK Youth" coordination meeting, attended by representative from all BN component parties, as part of the preparations to face the 13th general election, here Thursday.

Muammar said that the Kota Kinabalu BN youth wing had devised a strategy or new approach in reaching the people through various "touch point" programmes, particularly young voters.

"For the first time we will move as a united team, Whatever programmes organised by any BN component parties, the other component party members will give undivided support to ensure victory for BN," he said.

He stressed the coordination committee was the symbol of unity and solidarity among the Kota Kinabalu BN youth leaders towards mounting a strong challenge for the Kota Kinabalu Parliamentary seat.

"We have agreed to work hand in hand and go all out to wrest the seat from the DAP. We believe, with Najib's proven track record, coupled with a united Kota Kinabalu BN youth, we have a chance of winning the elusive seat," he said.

Muammar also expressed confidence that BN would retain the state seat of Api-Api and regain two other seats - Likas and Luyang under the Kota Kinabalu Parliamentary constituency, from the opposition Sabah Progressive Party (SAPP) in the next general election.
