

Disciplinary Committee Representatives In All Umno Divisions To Prevent Internal Sabotage

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 8 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak agreed for an Umno Disciplinary Committee representative to be appointed in all Umno divisions in an effort to prevent internal sabotage.

He said representatives chosen this year will be screened from among the seven division delegates sent by the divisions to the party's recent General Assembly.

"Their names will be announced at the divisions and for whatever happens at each division, there will be a representative to monitor the situation," he told reporters after chairing an Umno Supreme Council meeting at the Putra World Trade Centre here Friday.

He said the names of the representatives were being processed by the Umno Disciplinary Committee chaired by Tan Sri Tengku Ahmad Rithauddeen.

According to Najib, the representative was also responsible for lodging a report on any form of sabotage so that early action could be taken.

He said overall, today's meeting focused on preparations by Umno election machinery in facing the coming election.

"We've received an audit report up to district polling centres and based on the reports, we are pleased with the level of preparedness," he added.

Najib said he hoped that leaders in states, divisions as well as district polling centres will continue to strengthen the preparations.
