

Najib At Tea Party With Penang Chinese Community Leaders

GEORGE TOWN, Feb 10 (Bernama) - Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak began a two-day visit to Penang Sunday by attending a tea party with Chinese community leaders.
