

**Agong Presents Appointment Letters To MACC Advisory Board, SCC Members

KUALA LUMPUR, Jan 18 (Bernama) -- The Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah presented letters of appointment to members of the Anti-Corruption Advisory Board (ACAB) and the Special Committee on Corruption (SCC) at Istana Negara here Friday.

The appointees were Tunku Abdul Aziz Tunku Ibrahim as a member of ACAB and Mohd Yusmadi Mohd Yusoff as a member of SCC.

Tunku Abdul Aziz was the former president and founder of Transparency International Malaysia (TI-M) as well as the Deputy Chairman of Transparency International (TI), while Mohd Yusmadi, a lawyer by profession, is the Balik Pulau Member of Parliament.

The appointments were consented by the Yang di-Pertuan Agong as provided under Section 14 (2) of the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) Act 2009.

The appointment is for three years, from Sept 14 2012 to Feb 25 2015, for Tunku Abdul Aziz, and from Feb 24 2012 to Feb 25 2015 for Mohd Yusmadi.
