

**ATM Personnel Should Diligently Continue To Preserve Peace In Country - King

PORT DICKSON, Jan 19 (Bernama) -- Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah on Saturday reminded members of the Malaysian Armed Forces (ATM) to diligently continue to shoulder their responsibility of maintaining the country's peace and sovereignty against any threats.

He said the peace and prosperity the people were enjoying was not easily attained as it involved sacrifices by previous soldiers.

"Make the excellent struggle of previous warriors a source of inspiration to make the undivided loyalty pledge for the leadership towards upholding the integrity and well-being of Malaysia.

"The military discipline which forms the essence for the integrity of the military institution should be observed fully so that the reputation and prestige of ATM will always be preserved and looked up to by the society," he added.

The king said this when speaking at the Royal Parade and Conferment of Appointment Letters as Cadet Officers to 55 graduates of the Army College and 10 graduates from the royal vessel, the KD Sultan Idris 1, at the Segenting Camp here today.

The Raja Permaisuri Agong, Tuanku Hajah Haminah, was also present.

Others present included Negeri Sembilan Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Mohamad Hasan, ATM Chief General Tan Sri Zulkifeli Mohd Zin, Army Chief General Tan Sri Zulkifli Zainal Abidin, Navy Chief Admiral Tan Sri Abdul Aziz Jaafar and Deputy Air Force Chief Lieutenant General Datuk Seri Roslan Saad.

His Majesty also said that with the country's rapid development, ATM was not exempted from undergoing a modernisation process which required members of the force to continue to acquire knowledge.

This was to ensure their preparedness to face challenges and to maintain the credibility of ATM, he added.
