

DAP Member Ready To Put Party Sentiments Aside In Support Of PM's Efforts To Develop Nation

KAJANG, March 14 (Bernama) -- A DAP member who expressed support for Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak's excellent leadership qualities said he was ready to put party sentiments aside for the love of the country.

Lee Chee Cheng who is also the former Taman Megah DAP deputy chairman said he does not want to waste his vote for a lost cause during the 13th General Election.

"I am sensible and matured enough to evaluate the government's efforts to develop Malaysia because such efforts have succeeded until today.

"I love Malaysia. I also love DAP. But I like a clean DAP. I will not support a leader who is arrogant and full of deceit," he told reporters at a cafe in Bandar Sungai Long, here Thursday.

Though Lee, a stroke patient, had difficulty speaking due to his illness, however, was determined to read out the text that outlined the success enjoyed by the country under Najib's leadership.

Lee also urged the Registrar of Societies (ROS) to take action against DAP, suspend or deregister the party due to irregularities during DAP's Central Executive Committee (CEC) election on Dec 15.

"We, at the grassroots want DAP secretary-general Lim Guan Eng to stop his manipulation in the vote counting process. We want a re-election for CEC members," he said.

Lee did not rule out the possibility that he might also quit DAP if no action was taken by the opposition party despite calls for a CEC re-election by members from the grassroots.

Meanwhile, Sungai Pelek DAP branch chairman Tan Tuan Tuat who was also present at the cafe said he had received information that support for DAP had deteriorated in several areas.

"In several areas monopolised by DAP since 2008, voters have returned to Barisan Nasional (BN)," he said.
