

Najib Visits Families Of Two Fallen Heroes In Kelantan

KOTA BAHARU, March 15 (Bernama) -- Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak, on a day-long working visit to Kelantan Friday, found time to meet the families of two armed forces personnel who were killed by terrorists during 'Ops Daulat' in Sabah recently.

The prime minister and wife, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor, met the families of Cpl Ahmad Hurairah Ismail and Cpl Ahmad Farhan Ruslan at Masjid As-Solihin in the 8th Infantry Brigade camp, Pengkalan Chepa here.

Najib handed over personal contributions, as well as appreciation letters, to their family members to commemorate the services of the two national warriors.

Ahmad Hurairah, from Kampung Bayu Lalang, Pasir Mas, was killed in a gunbattle with terrorists in Sungai Nyamuk, Kampung Tanjung Batu in Lahad Datu, Sabah.

Ahmad Farhan, from Perumahan Desa Darulnaim II, Pasir Tumboh here died in a road accident at Km37 Lahad Datu-Tungku road while delivering food to security forces in the operation.

At the ceremony, Rosmah, who is president of the Welfare Association of Wives of Ministers and Deputy Ministers, handed over RM20,000 each to Rahmah Mamat, 50, the mother of Ahmad Hurairah, and Ruslawati Ghani, 44, mother of Ahmad Farhan.

Earlier, the prime minister's wife joined a prayer session, yassin recitation and tahlil, which was also attended by 300 wives of armed forces personnel, at the mosque.
