

Selangor BN Youth Launches 'Ops Kibar'

SHAH ALAM, March 20 (Bernama) -- Selangor Barisan Nasional (BN) Youth will launch a massive operation to put up the BN flag, dubbed 'Ops Kibar' at all strategic locations in 22 parliamentary constituencies in the state soon.

Its chairman Ungku Salleh Ungku Jamal said the operation was also aimed at showcasing BN's commitment to serve the people.

He said in a bid to reach out to young voters, Selangor BN Youth would also organise the final match of the Prime Minister Cup football tournament at Bukit Jelutong field this Sunday.

The tournament, which saw the participation of 15,000 industrial workers in Selangor, offers cash prizes totalling RM16,000.

In KUALA TERENGGANU, Terengganu police chief Datuk Jamshah Mustapa reminded political supporters to consider the safety aspect in putting up the party flags.
