

King, Queen Attend Police Day Dinner

KUALA LUMPUR, March 22 (Bernama) -- The Yang di-Pertuan Agong, Tuanku Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah and the Raja Permaisuri Agong, Tuanku Hajah Haminah Friday night attended a Royal Malaysia Police (PDRM) dinner to celebrate the 206th Police Day.

The dinner held at the Palace Of The Golden Horses Hotel was attended by Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin and his wife Puan Sri Noorainee Abdul Rahman, Home Minister Datuk Seri Hishammuddin Hussein and his wife Tengku Datin Seri Marsilla Tengku Abdullah as well as the Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Ismail Omar.
