

**China Wants To Enhance Economic Cooperation, Trade With Malaysia**

KUANTAN, March 23 (Bernama) - Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak said China is keen to enhance cooperation with Malaysia, especially in economic and trade.
