

Muhyiddin Chairs MCPF Annual Meeting

KUALA LUMPUR, March 23 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin today chaired the annual meeting of the Malaysia Crime Prevention Foundation (MCPF) at Bukit Aman, here.

Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Ismail Omar said the meeting discussed, among other things, programmes to be implemented in the future to make the MCPF more effective.
