

Malaysia-New Zealand Trade On Uptrend After FTA Signing

PETALING JAYA, Feb 26 (Bernama) -- Bilateral trade between Malaysia and New Zealand has been on an uptrend since both countries signed a Free Trade Agreement (FTA) over two years ago, says the New Zealand Trade and Enterprise.

Its Trade Commissioner to Malaysia, Indonesia and Brunei, Fiona Acheson said trade between both countries, roughly amounted to one billion New Zealand dollars, each way.

"The trade has been increasing annually and Malaysia is an important trade partner for New Zealand," she told a press conference at the New Zealand Fair 2013 at the Aeon Bandar Utama.

The fair here is from today until March 13, while that at the Aeon Supermarkets at the Mid Valley and Taman Maluri, would be held between Feb 28 to March 13.

Aeon Co (M) Bhd Assistant General Manager of Foodline Merchandising Division, Hiroko Yamada said the group had a higher sales target of RM300,000 for the New Zealand Fair this year compared with RM250,000 in 2012.
