

Special Allocation From PM For Kuching Indian Association

KUCHING, March 26 (Bernama) -- A special allocation of RM300,000 by the federal government from the Prime Minister to the Kuching Indian Association here, today shows that the government does not neglect any community in the country, said Dewan Rakyat Deputy Speaker Datuk Wan Junaidi Tuanku Jaafar.

Wan Junaidi, who is also the Member of Parliament for Santubong, said the government led by Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak demonstrated the efforts of the Prime Minister in fulfilling the needs of all the communities regardless of race and religion.
