KUALA LUMPUR, March 9 (Bernama) -- The Malaysia-Palestine Youth Movement (MPYM) delegation got a chance to spend their last day in Malaysia with Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak Saturday.

In a statement issued Saturday, MPYM said the delegation from Palestine got that chance when Najib attended a luncheon hosted by Melaka Chief Minister Datuk Seri Mohd Ali Rustam in Melaka today.

During that event, Najib, who also the patron of MPYM, expressed his satisfaction on the efforts by MPYM to continue to provide assistance to the Palestinian people especially at the international level.
