

AirAsia Offers Special Deals In Conjunction With 13th General Election

KUALA LUMPUR, April 10 (Bernama) -- Frills-free airline, AirAsia Bhd, is offering low fares to Malaysians who will be travelling home to cast their votes in the 13th General Election.

Chief executive officer, Aireen Omar, said low fares were expected to help Malaysians fly back for the polling day which would be held on May 5.

"We foresee many Malaysians will be making travel plans to return to their respective constituents to carry out their responsibilities as voters.

"Flying back to vote would be a better choice, especially with AirAsia's high frequencies for domestic flights, which will enable many to plan a day trip for the election, and probably the best way to avoid congestion on the highways," she said in a statement today.

AirAsia said Malaysians from Indonesian cities could return to vote for an all-in-fare from as low as RM55 one way, while airfare would start from as low as RM120 and RM124 one way for travellers from Singapore and other Asean cities, respectively.

As for domestic flights throughout Malaysia, all-in-fare starts from RM29 one way for routes such as Kuala Lumpur to Johor Baharu, Penang, Alor Setar, Terengganu, Langkawi and more.

The special offer also includes flights operating from AirAsia's other hubs nationwide, as well.

The low-cost carrier said the low fares are already available for booking on AirAsia's website, www.airasia.com for immediate travel period, as well as via its' mobile booking platforms through WAP-enabled phones at mobile.airasia.com and AirAsia apps on iPhone and Android devices.
