

BN Government's Transformation Programme Looks After All Races - Muhyiddin Bernama

KUALA LUMPUR, April 5 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin said the transformation programme implemented by the Barisan Nasional (BN) government looks after the welfare of all strata of society.

"I dare say that the transformation programmes carried out by the BN government have not ignored any cluster of the community.

"Everyone is looked after and aid extended to them," he said at a gathering after Friday prayers at the Madrasah Islahiah Addiniah, Taman Ibu Kota, here Friday.

In this regard, Muhyiddin said the people should give their mandate to the BN in the 13th general election (GE13) to ensure that the national transformation agenda could be continued.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak had announced the dissolution of the Dewan Rakyat on Wednesday to make way for the GE13.

At the gathering, Muhyiddin also handed out aid amounting to RM52,000 from the Federal Territory Islamic Religious Council to 26 fire victims in Kg Puah, here recently.

The BN deputy chairman said the country's transformation efforts should be continued to achieve the developed nation status by 2020 with only a few more years left.

He said Najib had already prepared a massive programme which was supported by him and his cabinet colleagues, and it was important to see that the transformation policy was not hindered.

Muhyiddin also stressed that the government led by the BN had gained vast experience in managing the country including in the aspects of the economy, education, security and solidarity after having helmed the nation for more than five decades.

"Although we have administered the country for 55 years, the party is not old, the leaders have changed and are in fact more energetic than before, they are capable, have the right vision and ambition.

"And of greater importance, we understand the aspirations of the people," he pointed out.
