

**Muhyiddin Confident That Manifesto Will Promise More Secure Future**

KUALA LUMPUR, April 6 (Bernama) -- Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin is confident that the Barisan Nasional (BN) manifesto to be launched by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak tonight will promise a more secure future for the next five years.

The deputy prime minister said the Malaysian people should scrutinise the manifesto and compare it with that of the opposition's.

"For me, the BN manifesto is an agreement between the BN and the people, that will bring much more prosperity, development and progress, particularly as the next five years are very crucial for us to achieve the developed nation status," he said.

Muhyiddin said this to reporters after visiting Lembah Pantai where he also stopped for breakfast at the Gerai Singgah Santai at Kondo Rakyat Desa Pantai, here today.

"We wait and see what the prime minister would say tonight. I do not want to steal the thunder. This is a serious occasion, something that needs to be conveyed by the BN on the next five years to the Malaysian population."

Najib, who is BN chairman, will launch the manifesto at the '1Malaysia People First' gathering at Stadium Putra, Bukit Jalil here at 9pm.
