

**BN Manifesto Based On Friendly Survey And Public Feedback - Najib

KUALA LUMPUR, April 8 (Bernama) -- The Barisan Nasional (BN) manifesto presented last Saturday had been drawn up carefully after a friendly survey and various efforts were carried out to get the feedback from all strata of society, said Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak Monday.
