

BN Manifesto Realistic And Practical, Says Malaysian Senators Council

SEREMBAN, April 9 (Bernama) -- The Malaysian Senators Council sees the Barisan Nasional (BN) manifesto for the 13th general election as realistic and practical as it has taken into consideration the BN government's past achievements and its capacity for fulfilling its promises in future.

Its chairman, Senator Datuk Najeeb Abdullah said the manifesto indicated the seriousness of the BN government under the leadership of Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Abdul Razak to improve services for the people, whether in the urban or rural areas.
