

MAICCI Invites Opposition Leaders To Visit Its BN Friendly Information Centre

KLANG, April 10 (Bernama) -- The Malaysian Associated Indian Chamber of Commerce and Industry (MAICCI) has invited opposition leaders, including Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim to visit their Barisan Nasional Friendly Information Centre (BN) that has been opened, here.

MAICCI President Datuk K.K.Eswaran said all opposition leaders can come and witness for themselves a list of assistance provided by the BN government to assist the Indian community.

"I invite Anwar and other leaders like Charles Santiago, Ronnie Liu and M. Manoharan to come and see what the BN government has done. So far what have they (opposition) done?" he told reporters after opening the centre at Jalan Raya Timur, here, Wednesday.

He said the government had provided various assistance to the Indian community, including RM500 million for building Sekolah Jenis Kebangsaan Tamil schools and temples.

Eswaran said the centre in Klang was the fourth opened by MAICCI after Johor, Penang and Melaka.
