

Muhyiddin Chairs Federal Territory BN Meeting

KUALA LUMPUR, April 3 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin Wednesday chaired a closed-door meeting of the Federal Territory Barisan Nasional (BN) at the Putra World Trade Centre, here.

Muhyiddin, who is also Federal Territory BN chairman, arrived at 2pm to chair the meeting, which lasted more than an hour.

Hemmed in by journalists after the meeting, he only smiled and made the sign of zipping up his mouth.

Meanwhile, Gerakan president Tan Sri Dr Koh Tsu Koon, when asked to comment, said Muhyiddin stressed on the need for the BN campaign to be conducted in a courteous and matured manner and wanted coalition members to work harder.

For Gerakan itself, Koh said, the party was making appropriate preparations to meet voters.

He, nevertheless, was confident the transformation programme implemented by the government was a plus point for the BN.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak announced the dissolution of Dewan Rakyat today to pave the way for the 13th general election.
