

**Najib Visits Family Of Late ACP Ibrahim Lebar In Subang Jaya**

KUALA LUMPUR, April 7 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak today visited the family of the late ACP Ibrahim Lebar who was killed in Ops Daulat recently, at the family home in Subang Jaya, near here.

Najib who arrived at the house at 4.10pm, spent about 45 minutes talking with the late Ibrahim's widow, Rosiah Dahlan, 52, and their children.

He also handed over a contribution of RM20,000 from Yayasan Kelana Ehsan to Rosiah to lighten the family's financial burden.

Also present were Agriculture and Agro Industry-based Minister Datuk Seri Noh Omar, Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Ismail Omar and Selangor police chief Datuk Tun Hisan Tun Hamzah.

Rosiah said she was touched by Najib's visit although he had a tight schedule, especially with the looming 13th general election.

"I am very thankful to the government and Royal Malaysian Police for giving us a lot of support since our loss, while the prime minister has also given us words of encouragement," she said.

The late ACP Ibrahim was among six police personnel killed in an ambush by a group of militants from southern Philippines in the water village of Kampung Sri Jaya, Siminul in Semporna, Sabah in February.
