

Pahang BN Additional Manifesto To Be Distributed On Nomination Day

BANDAR TUN ABDUL RAZAK, April 8 (Bernama) -- Pahang Barisan Nasional (BN) will distribute its own additional manifesto during the nomination day of the 13th general election.

Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Adnan Yaakob said the manifesto would be printed four major languages, namely Malay, Chinese, Tamil and English.

He said the manifesto covered most issues related to housing, land, environment, youth and economy.

"The additional manifesto will tell the people about the efforts to be taken by the BN-led Pahang government for the benefit and wellbeing of the people, besides increasing the state's revenue.

"This is not a joke. The state government will really work hard to develop the state in line with the transformation brought by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak," he told reporters after presenting land titles to 671 FELDA settlers in FELDA Jengka 21 and 22 here today.

On the BN election manifesto, Adnan, who is also Pahang BN chairman, said the manifesto was sincere pledges to fight for the people and improve their standard of living.

He said the prime minister's pledge to establish an urban ministry to overcome social problems in urban areas and to give extra attention to the Indian and Orang Asli communities, was most welcomed.

"The BN manifesto and pledges were clear and practical, with the objective to help the people, compared with the opposition's manifesto which only aimed at fishing votes," he added.
