

**Subramaniam Urges Indian Community To Support Najib**

PUTRAJAYA, April 9 (Bernama) -- MIC deputy president Datuk Seri Dr S. Subramaniam today urged the Indian community to give Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak a fresh five-year mandate to better serve the community.

"Give the prime minister another five years to see better results as we (the Barisan Nasional) can do much more. I hope the Indian community can understand that," he said.

He said Najib had explained in detail everything he had initiated for the Indian community and how they were well received in a special interview on the Tamil edition of BernamaTV's 'Helo Malaysia' programme last night.

"The efforts by the prime minister to address issues of the Indian community are very positive.

"My message to the Indian community is that the process of transformation has begun. Four years was insufficient," he said.

Asked about Indian support for the Barisan Nasional (BN) in the coming general election, Subramaniam said 55 to 65 per cent of Indians supported the BN, depending on the areas.

"This is much better than in 2008 when the support was only 40 to 50 per cent," he said.
