

Muhyiddin Attends Friday Prayers In Keramat

KUALA LUMPUR, April 12 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin today performed Friday prayers with 1,500 people at the Al Akram Mosque in Keramat, here.
