

**GE13: PKR Names Three More Candidates For Sarawak, To Contest 14 Seats**

KUCHING, 18 April (Bernama) -- Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR) today announced three more candidates for the parliamentary seats in Sarawak, bring the total number of seats it will be contesting in the state in the 13th General Election (GE13) to 14 seats.

PKR's director of its main operations room Sabaruddin Mohd Yasim told reporters here today that they were Andy Wong Hong Yu (Julau), Willie Mongin (Mambong) and Boniface Willy Tumek (Mas Gading).

Prior to this, PKR had announced that its state information chief Baru Bian would contest Limbang, Ali Biju (Saratok), Abang Zulkifli Abang Engkeh (Batang Lupar), Abun Sui Anyie (Hulu Rajang), Roland Engan (Baram), Nicholas Bawin (Lubok Antu), Thomas Laja (Kanowit), Joshua Jabeng (Selangau), Zulrusdi Hol (Santubong), Cecilia Siti Una (Betong) and Ahmad Nazib Johari (Petra Jaya).

In PETALING JAYA, PKR deputy president Mohamed Azmin Ali announced that PKR would be contesting 102 parliament and 162 state seats in GE13.

This is five additional parliamentary seats as compared to the 97 seats the party contested in the last general election.

Mohamed Azmin added that an agreement had not been reached on two seats with its Pakatan partners and that one of them was Labuan, which PAS also wanted.
